#### **Principals Report** ~ Current population 335

Mrs Sally and Mrs Walker – were scheduled to drive, and due to medical issue she was not. Parents stepped up to help. District track meet – top 2 kids in each events (max of 3) of grade 4's and 5's to attend.

Some parent helpers will be their helping. All are excited about PAC supplied snacks

Grade 5's are getting very excited about moving on to the middle school! Very successful Trinity Western field trip. Mr. Everson and 4 students came by to talk to the grade 5's about middle school and to answer questions from the kids. All the grade 5's will walk over to Yorkson on June 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup>. Kids that need a 2<sup>nd</sup> visit/special needs/anxious.

Sports day ~ Mr. Kreoker will be bringing 12-18 kids from the leadership program to come and run the stations. Paper notice was sent home

School plan – June  $2^{nd}$  10:30 they will be sharing the school's action plan. Parents are invited. The first part is "meeting" and the  $2^{nd}$  part is classroom visits and viewing of the leadership program, how the kindergarteners use technology. Interactive session.

FSA's – (grade 4's) and district numeracy test (grade 3's), writing (grade 1's & 5's)

When we opened 3 years ago 41% of our grade 1's could not read. Were we spending too much time on numeracy? Kids have tablets, not books. They don't sit down to read. They know from grade 10 results that kid need a c+ or above to be successful. A lower end of a c is not a pass. Last year 53% scored 53% or above, this year 63%.

At the end of grade 1, half of those kids couldn't read. Of those kids by the end of grade 2 half of those were still not at grade level. Everything the PAC puts into literacy the school matches.

If in grade 5 they are still struggling in reading/decoding/comprehension, then they are given additional assistance. This year 81.25 % in numeracy! Reading comprehension. Grade 1 kids  $^{\sim}$  are saying we don't do books in our house. How do you teach something that the parents don't support? Need to get 80% of our kids understanding comprehension.

Likely to get to 575 next year. Will have 5 teaching vacancy's for next year. (June 16 they'll let us know who's retiring). Mrs. Boles is in the process of hiring. Most of the classes will be straight classes.

All our grade 4 & 5 classes will be split next year and the teachers will work as a team.

Lets teachers teach to their strengths. Schools are taking letter grades out and going to the number grade system. Allows for more individualized assessments. Will be 3 kindergarten classes next year.
